

"Keep Chanute Clean" Dumpster Program



The dumpster program lasts all year, from January through December. The dumpsters are three (3) cubic yards in size. There is no charge for the use of this dumpster service.

To receive a dumpster, call the City of Chanute Landfill at (620)431-5268 during the hours of 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday through Friday, and from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm (noon) on Saturday. The free dumpsters are on a first come first serve basis. Depending on the time of year, it will take anywhere from one day to four weeks, or more, to receive a dumpster. If you know when you'll need a dumpster for clean-up, it's a good idea to call in advance as the list is long during the warmer months. When you call you will be told what day the dumpster will be available. Dumpsters are delivered and removed between 1:00 pm and 3:00 pm, Monday through Friday.

Dumpsters are left at each address no more than two days and will be dumped the day after it is set and again at the time of pick-up. You may schedule a dumpster twice a year (per address); and you may only reserve one date of service at a time. The address must be inside the city limits. **ONCE DUMPSTER IS SET BY THE SANITAION DEPARTMENT IT SHALL NOT BE MOVED BY CUSTOMER.**

Items that may be placed in the dumpster include:



Metal, household or yard furniture, toys, used motor vehicle parts, household appliances, clothes, shoes, etc. **NOTE: NO APPLIANCES ACCEPTED UNLESS PROPER PAPERWORK SHOWING REFRIGERANT HAS BEEN PROPERLY RECOVERED BY A LICENSED PROFESSIONAL EPA REGULATIONS (40 CFR PART 8 SUBPART F).**

Items that may NOT be placed in the dumpster include:



Household garbage (which is picked up regularly each week), leaves, or grass clippings. The dumpsters are not to be used for demolition or remodeling purposes. Absolutely NO concrete, rocks, dirt, tires, motor oil, batteries, paint, paint thinner or any other household hazardous waste.

NOTE: If items that are not permitted in the dumpster are in the dumpster, they will be dumped out where the dumpster sits.

Small limbs (under 2" in diameter) and brush can be taken to the landfill for free. Leaves can be taken to the compost area at the Waste Water Treatment Plant.

SPECIAL NOTE: The dumpster program is designed for **City of Chanute Residents Only.**

NO OVERLOADING

Dumpsters will not be emptied if the dumpster is overloaded.
